# COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

### Community Pledge

The wellness of our community is the social responsibility of each and every one of us. As a community, we have a responsibility to each other to do what is best for our collective whole. I/we, commit to:

### FOLLOW FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GUIDANCE.

All community members are expected to follow directives from the national, state, and local authorities to maintain their own health and safety during this pandemic, both in and outside of school. These include Utah Department of Health and the CDC Guide on Protecting Yourself and Others.

### REPORT IF SOMEONE TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 OR HAS PENDING RESULTS.



If a student, employee or **any member of their household** tests positive for COVID-19 or is awaiting test results, notify the director as soon as possible. The information will remain confidential but will allow the school necessary action to mitigate risk within our community.

### STAY HOME IF SICK.



Any community member showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 must not come to school. Parents/guardians must keep sick students home and away from others and report illness to the director. Our virtual class with Ms. Annie will be provided for free during the time that any student is self-isolating.

### STAY HOME IF EXPOSED.

Any member of a household who has been notified by the State Health Department that they were in contact with an individual infected with COVID-19 must notify the director as soon as possible. Based on the circumstance, the community member may be asked to stay home for 10 - 14 days. During this time our virtual class with Ms. Annie will be provided for free.

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## **PARTICIPATE IN HEALTH SCREENINGS AND TEMPERATURE CHECKS.**



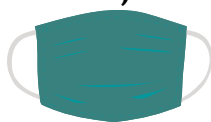
All parents/guardians, teachers and co-ops are required to participate in a health questionnaire. Additionally the parent/guardians AND child will be required to do a temperature check at drop-off.

## **GET VACCINATED**



All co-oping community members must be vaccinated against Covid-19 in order to volunteer within our classrooms. Non-vaccinated adults will not be able to be members of CCNS unless they have a medical exemption approved by the board of directors.

## **MOST IMPORTANTLY, WEAR A FACE MASK.**



Everyone is required to wear a face mask at all times during school events. Cloth face coverings need to be laundered daily. If a student forgets their face covering a disposable one will be provided.

Face shields and gaiters are not approved face coverings.

## **PRACTICE EXCELLENT HYGIENE**



Wash hands often with soap for at least 20 seconds – especially after being in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, sneezing, or using the restroom. If soap and water are not readily available, use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

### **Students should use the restroom and wash hands with soap and water before arriving to class location.**

We recommend parents keep hand sanitizer in the car and use at drop-off and pick-up.
